WORKSHOP ON NEW CRIMINAL LAWS IN INDIA AT LEH, LADAKH

Navigating this new 'justice-centric' legal landscape is not optional—it is a critical mandate for every legal and administrative professional. This essential NAHRD workshop is meticulously designed to provide the comprehensive, practical mastery required to transition seamlessly. By focusing on the direct impact on investigation protocols, evidence admissibility (especially digital evidence), and the definition of new offences, participants will gain the confidence to ensure full statutory compliance, procedural efficiency, and judicial readiness under the new codes. - Strengthen institutional preparedness and compliance

Workshop Methodology

The workshop will be conducted through expert-led interactive sessions combining conceptual inputs with comparative analysis of old and new criminal provisions. Practical insights will be shared through case-based discussions, real-life illustrations, and focused Q&A sessions, enabling participants to clearly understand the changes, implications, and application of the new criminal codes in their professional roles.etc.

Subject Experts having practical working knowledge and experience on the subject will be invited as faculty for the present workshop.
